Powabyke, in partnership with Saga, are giving away a pair of their latest electric bikes to one lucky reader

The X-bykes up for grabs are the LS (popular with ladies) and an X-6 (a gents bike that looks like a mountain bike). These bikes are ideal for effortless cycling and have a throttle on the handlebars to assist when the rider doesn't feel like pedalling. They are propelled by an electric battery and a motor and as well as being an enjoyable way to get around, they are environment friendly and easy on the pocket to run, having only to be topped up at the plug socket for 3-5 hours when re-charging.

Both the bikes, the LS and the X-6 from the new X-bike range, can achieve speeds of 15mph on their own propulsion and can go on a single charge for about 10 miles without even using the pedals.

You simply turn a key to start the 250 watt motor, get on the bike, make a revolution of the pedals and twist the handle-bar throttle and away you go, effortlessly conquering hills and getting to your destination with ease. By using the pedals now and again the bike's streamlined and lightweight electric battery can last for up to 20 miles. The battery can be recharged in 3-5 hours from a plug socket or, alternatively, you can purchase a second battery to save time.

Both bikes are designed to the highest standard with Shimano gears and height-adjustable centre stands. They are relatively light - weighing under 23kg and, to the untrained eye, they look like traditional road bikes, if very stylish ones. They both look great in polished silver with the battery, electric, and motor integrated into the bike seamlessly.

The Mark 2 X-bike models featured in this competition are the LS (low step through) and the X-6 - a six-speed bike with crossbar. Both models, in previous versions, are very popular and, in a users' survey conducted by Powabyke and Leeds University, 38% of users replaced their car for most trips and 77% of users said they ride the bikes on a daily basis.

Both the LS and the X-6 retail at £895 each.
